OUR MEMORABLE CRUISE ON THE DANUBE

Recently, my husband Mark and I experienced the romance, history and beauty of the "Blue Danube" as we cruised this legendary area with Viking River Cruises.

Our journey began in Budapest, Hungary...a city (technically, two cities on either side of the Danube) that we were unprepared to love as much as we did. Taking advantage of Viking's pre-cruise package gave us an extra two days and nights in the charming Castle District. We visited the iconic Parliament building, explored the three-story Central Market and so much more. One memorable stop on our tour was the Great Synagogue (aka the Central Synagogue) on Dohány Street, which is the largest synagogue of Europe and the second largest one in the world. Also on that site are the Central Synagogue Jewish Museum and the Raul Wallenberg Memorial Park, home to the Emanuel Tree Memorial dedicated to Hungarian

Jews killed during the Holocaust.

The first official night of the cruise was spent onboard a beautiful Viking longship, docked in downtown Budapest. The next morning we enjoyed a leisurely cruise to Vienna, where we toured the city... such fun seeing the home of the famed Lipizzaner stallions! While in Vienna, you must visit the exquisite Schönbrunn Palace, a palatial complex that is a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site. A special Viking treat was an evening at the opera – a private performance of "The Marriage of Figaro," where we met the cast members.

Cruising upriver took us through the beautiful Wachau Valley, blanketed with vineyards and dotted by colorful villages. Another highlight for us was the Melk Abbey, a massive baroque Benedictine monastery with beautiful ceiling paintings and more than 90,000 volumes and rare manuscripts.

We really enjoyed Passau, Germany – great gift-shopping – even though I got separated from our group (too much photo taking) and followed my map on my own walking tour around Old Town, talking to friendly locals as I found my way to our meeting spot... actually a lot of fun!

On our walking tour of Regensburg, one of Europe's best-preserved medieval cities, we saw impressive 13th and 14th century church spires, towers and homes. One optional tour I urge you to take is a visit to the BMW factory. It is a fascinating behind-thescenes look at a combination of robotics and "worker-friendly" assembly lines.

The last stop on our cruise was Nuremberg. While our day there was more sobering, it was an eye-opening look at history we only thought we

CRUISING THROUGH FRANCE



In Tournon, cross over the suspension bridge to Tain l'Hermitage to taste Côtes du Rhône wines. Or, take a guided hike through the Hermitage vineyards and taste distinctive local wines.

In Macon, learn about Burgundy's celebrated wines at the Hospices de Beaune, where the monks have been making and selling wine to support their charitable work since the 15th century.

Lyon has developed a reputation as a major center of French cuisine. Enjoy a guided tour of Les Halles, Lyon's world-famous food market, and check out an array of food stalls, bars and restaurants. During a tour of the Quartier Saint-Jean, you'll meet an artisan who specializes in silk weaving.




